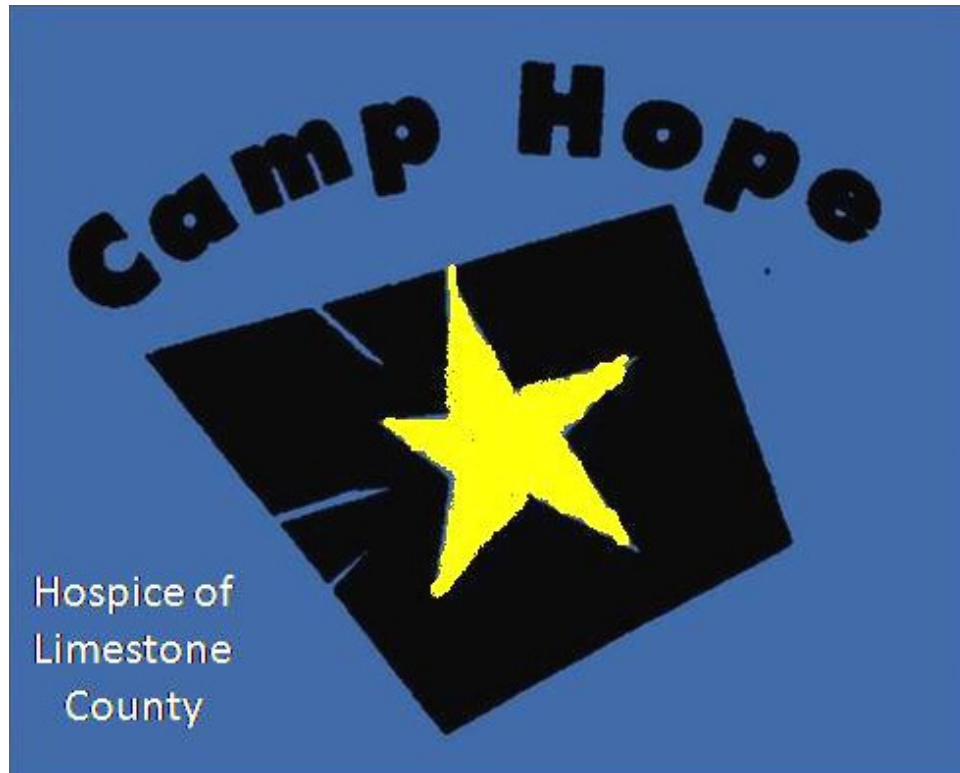


It's Almost Time for...



Camp Hope is a free, one day summer camp for kids and teens ages 5 to 15 that have experienced the death of a loved one.

Who: Campers are any child or teen ages 5 to 15 who lives in Limestone County

When: Tuesday, June 7, 2011 from 9 am to 3:30 pm

Where: at Camp Helen Baptist Campground in the East Limestone community just off Capshaw Road

How: Children can be registered through school counselors or by calling the Hospice office at 256.232.5017

Events include: hanging out with other kids who've experienced loss, crafts and memory books, swimming, fishing, water slides, water balloon battles, face painting, etc. etc. :0)

Volunteers Needed!!!!

Anyone wishing to volunteer at Camp Hope must be 16 years old and go through one training session at the Hospice office, 405 S. Marion Street. (The office is located on Marion Street between Whitt's BBQ and the Courthouse. The building backs up to the railroad tracks.) "Buddy volunteers" are paired one-on-one with a camper to hang out and enjoy the day! Buddy volunteers are mostly teenagers who come highly recommended through local schools and have gone through Camp Hope training.
